reminded in Genesis 22:8 "Abraham said, "God will provide for himself the lamb for a burnt offering, my son." So they went both of them together." It has been a busy, but fast July. Our trip to Tennessee and Texas has been a blessing both in their own unique ways. We have handed out many Bibles from truck stops along the way to servers in restaurants. It was amazing to pray with folks from all walks of life, as we shared the Gospel of Jesus Christ with them. While in TN, we had the opportunity to be an encouragement and blessing to the staff at the hotel. Our trip to TX took us downtown Houston to bring Hope found only in Christ to the homeless. We listened to their stories,



handed out basic toiletry kits, and spent time with each person to let them know we care, and God loves them. We were not able to get her name, but one lady in particular was very talkative and thankful we took the time to spend with her. She wanted to know more about our ministry and was so encouraged that she too wanted to help others when she got back on her feet. It may be a shocking number, but we find that 1 out of 5 homeless people really want help to get back on their feet and she was one of them. What a blessing it is to be a blessing to others in a time of need. Seeds were planted on both trips, and we ask that you pray for the people we were able to minister to.

The Lord has been so good and faithful to us through the years, and this year is no different. Each year gets better, as we are given more opportunities to go more places with

the Gospel. Our trip to South Africa is coming up quickly! While there, we are going to be able to do some street evangelism, church services, backyard Bible studies, play with the kids, cookouts, go into the schools, hand out resources like Bibles, and help work on building dormitories for future mission teams to come serve. The best part of it all, we will be sharing the Gospel in all we do! Over the past few years, we have prayed for an opportunity for our



whole team to go serve overseas. We had no intentions of going on a mission trip this year, but God placed this opportunity in our path that we could not pass up. We thank the Lord for all the money He has given us towards this trip, as we raise our own support to go. We also want to thank each of you for your donations.
