Guatemala Mission Trip

Hey y'all:

What an exciting opportunity we have been given to return to Guatemala again this fall. This is a unique opportunity being that Matt has been invited to preach by Pastor Marlon at the church in Xenacoj. What a humbling experience and yet an exciting time in the life of our ministry!

Here is some information regarding the Guatemala mission trip our ministry team will be going on. Many people have asked for more information, and we thought this would be the best way to share with everyone at once. The dates are September 5th-11th. The cost is \$1550 per person. NOTE: All three of us are going! Parkview Baptist Church has ordered plane tickets to help secure the biggest cost for everyone going on our team. There will be roughly 12-15 people!

Regarding the trip, here are some of the plans. Please keep in mind these are flexible plans that could change somewhat. Scot Farris from Parkview will lead the trip. There will be various ministries happening during our time there:

1. The team will be involved in construction. They will have other construction teams coming prior to us, so there is still some uncertainty on our exact project at this time. Most likely it will be helping with the construction of homes to include installation of stoves.

2. The team will possibly be involved in school evangelism and Bible classes at the local schools. This is a great opportunity to go to the schools and share testimonies while teaching the Bible and cooking a meal to feed them lunch.

3. The team will likely be involved in home visits and home Bible studies. This may take place in the evenings.

Hands of Hope International is the group Parkview works with while there. Depending on the work teams this summer, this may change the direction of the trip. It's possible we do all of the things mentioned, possibly we do some of the things, and we could add a ministry or two.

This is the current info I have at this time regarding the trip. Please join us in prayer for how the Lord will use our ministry to partner with Parkview Baptist Church on this mission
