Do You Believe?

Hey y'all:

When did you believe in Christ as your Savior? In John 11:25-26 "Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?" When Jesus got to where Martha and Mary were, Lazarus had already died and been in the tomb for four days. When Martha met Jesus, she told Him her brother would not have died had He been there. Yet, she said I know God will grant You whatever You ask of Him! Jesus assured her Lazarus will rise again. Our feet hit the ground running at the start of the New Year. We are currently finalizing our calendar, amid raising the final \$20,000 needed for our 2026 operations budget. We give thanks to God for all He has provided from churches to individuals, including new donors to start off the New Year. Many thanks to each of you for your continued support through prayer and giving! We cannot do what we do without God first and then the sacrifice y'all give to support our ministry. We have several added new opportunities not in our budget for y'all to partner with us from overseas missions to the "Unashamed of The Gospel" tour in late summer out West. Also we have our annual backpack giveaway equipped with school supplies, a Bible, and track/life book. We are praying for the Lord to double last year! This event has become one of the biggest events we put on each year in July. God is so good, and He is able! Do you believe?



Many know that we are planning our first mission trip to lead a group to Michigan in June to help Scott Lake Baptist Church just north of Detroit in Waterford. We will be holding a commitment meeting this Sunday morning, January 11th, at Parkview Baptist Church in Tuscumbia, AL following the morning worship services at about 11:55AM in room A102. If you missed the interest meeting this past fall, we invite you to come be a part of this meeting. We are looking for people of all ages with various skill sets and experiences, to include



families. Whether you are local or live someplace else, we invite you to come with us to be a part of what God is doing in MI. As people commit, this will allow us to assess what we will be able to do and not do during our trip. If you have always wanted to go on a mission trip, but not overseas, here is your opportunity to come serve, love, and share Jesus right here in your backyard.

Over the next few months ahead, we will be embarking on some new adventures to share Jesus both locally and abroad. Please join us in prayer for some upcoming ministry meetings and opportunities. One in which we will be discussing about going to Guatemala to do a weeklong discipleship/evangelism training for pastors. Another is to come alongside a few new churches to do community outreach. There are also some churches that have invited us to come for a weekend, with the possibility to speak at their local schools during assembly time. As the weather warms up, we are prayerfully considering a block party/chapel service for the homeless community in the Shoals (Alabama) area. Most all these opportunities are new areas of ministry for us, and we are excited about what God is going to do. We are most excited to be joining Him where He is at work, as we help reach the lost for Christ.

What do we need from you? Prayer! Prayer is the most powerful and important thing we can do for each other. But not just prayer, also finances play a role in what we can and cannot do. Just like a church, we operate with a budget. We trust God to provide what we need to go be the hands and feet of Christ and that is often through generous folks like you.
